Over the years I've enjoyed finding special books, whether fiction or non-fiction. The dusty stacks of great libraries in great Gothic buildings have been special experiences, that still can't be beat by online sources. However, now it is easy to download a book and highlight and annotate, with the same being automatically saved in the cloud and on your device. Yet for some books with much depth, only a hard copy will do for penciled annotations and further reference. Finding a special quote in an eBook, for example, isn't as easy as in a printed book, due to our unique sense of spatial awareness and memory. While we have phenomenal memories if we choose to use them, highlights and notes are vital to recap readings and nurture meaningful scholarship and one's appreciation for the Universe. I'm sharing here titles of some print books in my actual library, some of which I may have referenced when advising students on their research, or mentoring. I can offer invitations to scholars to Google Drive for special, annotated/highlighted documents chosen ideally to be Open Access and/or in the Creative Commons, including those that are fodder for my current book project about our epistemic crisis; a book for the general reader or autodidact. Ideally also it will be a somewhat atypical, Creative Commons Open Access textbook/anthology; perhaps better than what I had to use teaching writing/research/rhetoric at University of Hartford and Charter Oak State College.

I'm also working on other projects: Such as my memoir of the 60's and 70's including my film of "Clown Day" 1975 in Hartford's Pope Park for city kids, with Ed Stivender, who today is described as "The Robin Williams of Storytelling." This was part of the amazing Hartford Arts Renaissance of the 1970s. A retrospective of that time in the form of a multimedia extravaganza is now being created with a group of artists from that time.

Another memoir or two with video will be a mix including some family history dating to the Mayflower and the Revolutionary War, my six years in seminary, anti-war activism, poetry and poems, and a cross-country motorcycle trip to work in California and hitchhike down the Pacific coast to rough it for a month at the beach in Mexico. Also a sci-fi fantasy novelette. I work on various writing-related projects, including grant writing, as a volunteer at the iconic Canton Historical Museum, Collinsville, CT. I am editor and owner at Emanations Press.
